Default and Game Cancellation Procedure

1. Game Cancellation (See Playing Rule 9 – revised April 2, 2011)
 - 1.1. Games cancelled due to weather (rain) or poor diamond conditions are to be rescheduled. Teams have 2 weeks from the date of cancellation to set a new date when the game can be played. If necessary, alternate or neutral diamonds should be used.
 - 1.2. If a rescheduled date is not set, the game is cancelled, no points are awarded and the team bond accounts are not affected.
 - 1.3. If a team refuses to reschedule or play a rescheduled game, the League Default Rules will apply.
 - 1.4. The home team will pay the costs for a rescheduled game on their home diamond or a neutral diamond.
 - 1.5. Games cancelled for OASA or Park special events will follow the rain out rules above.

2. Lack of Notice (See Playing Rule 20 – revised April 2, 2011)
 - 2.1. Lack of notice occurs when a game is cancelled within 24 hours of the scheduled playing date. The League Executive must also be informed of the cancellation.
 - 2.2. Games cancelled due to lack of notice are subject to the Default Rules.
 - 2.3. Lack of notice resulting from extenuating circumstances or local or municipal restrictions may be appealed to the Executive Committee for review. If approved by the Executive Committee, the game is subject to the Game Cancellation procedures above.

3. Default Rules (See Playing Rule 17 – revised March 5, 2011)
 - 3.1. A \$100 fine from the performance bond will be forfeited for the first defaulted game and transferred to defaulted teams bond account. The defaulted team will be awarded two (2) points for a win by forfeit.
 - 3.2. A second default will result in a further \$100 fine being forfeited to the defaulted team. Since the defaulting team's bond account is depleted, the full bond amount must be replenished prior to the defaulting team's next game. The defaulted team will be awarded two (2) points for a win by forfeit.
 - 3.3. In the event of a third default, the complete bond will be forfeited and the offending team will be suspended from further League play pending an Executive Committee review. The defaulted team will be awarded two (2) points for a win by forfeit.
